Nevada, Iowa -- The Story County Board of Supervisors is in the process of considering the best uses for the American Rescue Plan Act (also known as ARP; ARPA; Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; CSLFRF; and other names) funding allocation and invites residents to provide information to help identify the most pressing community needs. Among other uses, ARP is designed to aid counties in recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Story County residents have suffered as a result of this public health emergency. Story County is seeking community input on the use of the one-time funding available through the ARP that will most positively impact and benefit Story County's citizens.
